TOUR PRICE (\$3,200.00) INCLUDES:

Transportation: Roundtrip airfare from DFW to Tel Aviv - Israel.

Hotels: Deluxe 4-Star Hotel accommodations based on double occupancy. A single room supplementary fee of \$500.00 will be charged for those who desire a single room. Child (under 12) reduction: \$70.

Meals: Full Israel-style breakfast buffet and dinner daily. Lunch is not included in the package price. Participants should budget a minimum of \$10.00 per lunch meal daily. Soft drinks are not provided but may be purchased with your meals and charged to your hotel room (see more on footnote #3).

Baggage: One suitcase per person is permitted plus one carry-on bag not to exceed 45 inches in size. Suitcase is limited to 50 lbs.

Taxes: All airfare taxes are included. Any increase in these taxes or "Oil surcharges" added by the airlines, from the deposit due date onto the actual departure date, **ARE AT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TOUR PARTICIPANT!**

Tips: All gratuities and tips have been included in the price. Love offerings for the guide and driver plus extra tips are completely at the discretion of the tour participants.

Touring: All transportation is by a deluxe air-conditioned motor coach. All site entrance fees are included in the price. Sights added during the course of the tour may require additional fees from the participants.

TOUR ITINERARY

Day One (Friday, May 20th): Flight to Tel Aviv – Israel.

Day Two (Sabbath, May 21st): Drive us up to our hotel on the shores of the Sea of Galilee.



Day Three (Sunday, May 22nd): This day we start on the Mount of Beatitudes, pondering on our Lord's thoughts and teachings while on the mountainside. Next we will visit

Capernaum – Yeshua's 'headquarters'. Our next visit will be to an ancient fishing boat ("Yeshua's Boat") that was discovered on the sea shores after years of drought. Next we will give an

opportunity for these of you who wish to be baptized in the Jordan River! Finally, we will watch the sunset as we cross the Sea of Galilee by boat!



Day Four (Monday, May 23rd): Today we are going to visit the upper regions of Northern Israel and the main sources of the Jordan River at the feet of Mt. Hermon. We will start with a visit to Tel Dan (both the Tell and beautiful Nature Reserve). We will continue with a visit to Caesarea Philippi ("Baniyas"), and conclude the day with a beautiful drive up to the Golan Heights and a visit to an Israeli Bunker (Mt. Bental) overseen the Israeli-Syrian border.

Day Five (Tuesday, May 24th): Today we leave the Galilee area. We will drive by Nazareth and Cana to Megiddo ("Armageddon"). Next we are going to visit of the magnificent city of Beth Shean (1 Sam. 31:10), then drive to Gideon Springs, where we will be reminded of God's sovereignty and Might (Judge.6-7)! We then will make our way through the Jordan Valley and all the way to the shores of the Dead Sea, where we will have the opportunity to experience one of the most amazing phenomena – floating on the Dead Sea. We are going to spend that night on the Shores of the Dead Sea.

Day Six (Wednesday, May 25th): This day will start with a visit in the very last Jewish stronghold during the great

revolt against the Romans - Masada. Next, we are going to visit the beautiful nature reserve of Ein Gedi (1 Sam. 24). On our way to Jerusalem, we will stop at Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. We are going to reach the City of the Great King at dark, look at it from a wonderful lookout spot, on Mt. Scopus and check in our hotel, where the last three nights in the Holy Land will be spent!

Day Seven (Thursday, May 26th): After our delicious buffet-style breakfast, we will start our experience of the city of the Great King, with a visit at of a beautiful Model, depicting Jerusalem in the time of Yeshua. We are going to have a short visit to the Shrine of the Book, where some of the Dead Sea Scrolls are exhibited before boarding our bus again, and driving to the Old City. We will enter the Walled City of Jerusalem via the Jaffa Gate and walk through the very colorful and fragrancd Arab market, down to the Jewish quarter. Here we are going to have some very interesting visits, such as "The Burnt House" and "The Temple Institute" (Where some ultra-orthodox Jews are literally preparing for the building of the third Temple). Next we are going to visit the Southern Steps of the Temple Mount. Towards the end of the day, we will visit the very most holy site for Jews - The "Western Wall". We will speak of its importance to Jews (and non-Jews alike), have some time to pray at the Wall. Then, will experience one the most interesting and impressing sites in the Holy Land - A walk through the

"Rabbi's Tunnels"!

Day Eight (Friday, May 27th): This day of the tour will be dedicated mostly to the very last days of Yeshua's life! We are going to start on the Mount of Olives, with the magnificent view overlooking the city of Jerusalem, then walk down to Gethsemane, move on to Caiafa's house, and end the day at the Holocaust Museum.

Day Nine (Sabbath, May 28th): Sabbath Rest (A day off)! An optional fellowship and visiting with local Messianic believers in Yeshua (Jesus) will be provided! Late afternoon we will drive down to Tel Aviv/Jaffa, stroll the street of old Jaffa, have a fare well dinner and on to the airport for night flight back home.

Day Ten (Sunday, May 29th): Arrival back at the USA.
